(Washington, D.C.) – **Jack Claypoole**, Administrator of the Office of National Drug Control Policy’s Drug-Free Communities Program, which oversees 747 drug-free community coalitions, and Pennsylvania Congressman **Michael G. Fitzpatrick** will visit Quakertown, Pennsylvania on Monday, October 23<sup>rd</sup> to attend a press conference with Community Mobilizer **Lee Rush** of the Upper Bucks Healthy Communities Healthy Youth Coalition.

Administrator Claypoole, Congressman Fitzpatrick, and Mobilizer Rush will announce new substance abuse resources for Bucks County, and the results of the 2006 Student Support Card, the largest ever youth survey conducted on adolescent health and behaviors. They will discuss substance abuse trends in Upper Bucks County and highlight the local coalition’s first Social Norming Campaign to prevent underage drinking.
